EBAYC's Teaching Internship Program provides high school students an opportunity to tutor and mentor elementary school children in our After-School Learning programs.

As a Teaching Intern, you will:

- Maintain all academic and professional requirements as stated in the Education Internship Agreement (will be given at interview)
- Teach reading to a small group of elementary school students using a structured curriculum.
- Support and mentor elementary school students.
- Participate in monthly workshops with all Interns to share teaching and mentoring experiences; engage with guest educators; and relate work-based learning to personal and career interests.
- Produce and deliver a professional presentation of your internship experience from the school year
- Earn \$8.25 an hour for up to 10 hours a week for 36 weeks.

To be eligible, you must:

- Attend Oakland High School
- Be an incoming sophomore, junior, or senior in high school
- Have a 2.5 Total Academic Grade-Point-Average or above (please bring your most recent transcript to your interview)
- Have strong reading and writing skills
- Enjoys working with children.
- Be available to work Monday through Friday from 4pm to 6pm
